HAEBERLE's creative trolley system opens new dimensions for form and functionality conscious people. With the new **keo®** system you are able to create almost any type of functional trolley in a standardized design for your clinic. With its drawers, module full-pull-outs or elegant roller blinds of various heights, **keo®** optimally adapts to your furnishing ideas and your modern ambience. Flexible module support walls make it possible to accommodate ISO module baskets of all conventional brands – even at a later date. A new organisation concept provides uncluttered work surfaces.

The technology

- a rugged, torsionally stiff sheet metal construction of galvanized, high-quality, coated sheet metal. Resistant to disinfectants, easy to clean and light-resistant. Free of drumming due to single-tray construction. Very low weight!
- 4 elegant, anodised aluminium support profiles for mounting accessories. Subsequent mounting of accessories is also possible.
- an elegant, anodised aluminium push handle is standard.
- all module full-pull-outs are provided with an inset frame suitable for all conventional ISO module baskets. The pull-out is extendable up to approx. 110%, so that the module contents are comfortably and easily removable.
- drawers are equipped also with full-pull-outs (110%).
- inset frames and drawers with ball bearing telescopic guidance with self pull-in for easy gliding and comfortable use.
- high-quality, 125 mm Ø, smoothly-running castors with 2 brakes and with wall guards are standard. Electrically conductive castors are available at an additional price.
- total load of the trolleys up to approx. 130 kg.




